Mayor Atkinson advised Committee of the following changes to the agenda:

# 3. <u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES</u>

170206.02: It was moved and seconded that the minutes of the Committee of the Whole meeting of January 03, 2017, be approved as circulated. Motion carried.

# 4. <u>ACTION ITEMS</u>

#### 4.1 Appointment – Middleton Fire Department

170206.03: It was moved and seconded, on recommendation of the Middleton Fire Department, that Council appoint Jason J. Warrington as a member of the Middleton Fire Department. Motion carried.

### 4.2 Fire Hall Status Update

CAO Turner informed Committee of the report by Peter Smith of Eagle Project Management Inc. concerning the replacement of the existing fire station and community hall building with a new fire hall facility. The report was done in consultation with the Fire Department, the previous Council, and senior management of the Town. The report includes:

- history;
- goals;
- photo representation;
- funding requirements;
- cost comparisons;
- overview;
- potential floorplans;

Committee will discuss the new Fire Hall at a future meeting.

4.3 Special Reserve Fund Borrowing - Equipment

Director of Finance Daine informed Committee the 2017 Ford F250 truck is in the Capital Plan, part of the vehicle replacement plan and is an additional vehicle which can also be used for plowing.

# 170206.04: It was moved and seconded to recommend that Council authorize the borrowing of \$35,537.52 from the Land Sale Proceeds Elementary School Reserve Fund, with repayment over a five year term, at an annual interest rate of 1.68%, to finance the purchase of a 2017 Ford F250 4x4 truck. Motion carried.

Director of Finance Daine informed Committee the air packs are part of the Fire Department replacement plan with 50% of the funding coming from the Emergency Services Provider Fund.

170206.05: It was moved and seconded to recommend that Council authorize the borrowing of \$20,000 from the Industrial Park Land Reserve Fund, with repayment over a five year term, at an annual interest rate of 1.68% to finance the Town's portion of the purchase of four air packs. Motion carried.

# 4.4 <u>RFD 001-2017: Reallocation of Capital Funding – Speed Signs</u>

170206.06: It was moved and seconded to recommend that Council approve the reallocation of capital funding to enable the purchase of two speed signs. Motion carried.

4.5 Industrial Park Taxation

170206.07: It was moved and seconded to recommend that Council direct staff to apply the Middleton Industrial Park Taxation Rate to PID 05267174 located in the Middleton Industrial Park for the 2017-18 taxation year. Motion carried.
