

CHAPTER 2 - BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN

Council: January 7, 1935

Minister: January 17, 1935

The boundaries of the Town of Middleton are and are hereby declared to be as follows: Beginning at a point on the north bank of the Annapolis River in the County of Annapolis at the south west angle of lands of Robie Morton; thence northwardly along the west line of lands of the said Robie Morton to the north boundary line of said lands of said Robie Morton; thence continuing in a line with the said west line of said Robie Morton's lands northerly until it meets the south boundary line of the new Brooklyn Road extended eastwardly; thence westwardly in a line with the said south boundary line of the said new Brooklyn Road to the west line of lands of Owen Wheelock; thence southwardly along the said west line of said Owen Wheelock's land to the north side line of West Street; thence westwardly along the north side line of said West Street to the east side of the Dodge Road; thence southwardly along the said east side line of the said Dodge Road to the north boundary line of lands of the Dominion Atlantic Railway Company; thence westwardly along the north boundary line of the said Dominion Atlantic Railway Company's land westwardly to the eastern line of lands of Frank Palmer; thence southwardly along the said eastern line of said Frank Palmer's land to the southern boundary of said Frank Palmer's land; thence in line with the said eastern boundary line of said Frank Palmer's land southwardly to the north bank of the Annapolis River; thence by the north bank of the said Annapolis River eastwardly to the place of beginning.
