A regular meeting of the Middleton Police Advisory Board (PAB) was held at the Town Hall on Tuesday, October 8, 2024, starting at 5:00 pm.

Chairing the meeting, David McCoubrey, Deputy Mayor Gail Smith; Members John Thompson Councillors John Bartlett and Bernadette Knapp; RCMP member Sgt. Lindsay Powers, and Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) Ashley Crocker; Recording Secretary, Sara Marceau.

Also in attendance: Nine (9) citizens

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chair McCoubrey called the meeting to order at 5:00 pm.

2. APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA

241008.01 It was moved and seconded to accept the agenda as amended. **Motion carried.**

3. MINUTES

3.1. Approval of the Minutes

241008.02 It was moved and seconded to approve the minutes of July 8, 2024, circulated. **Motion carried.**

4. OLD BUSINESS

4.1. Police Advisory Board Training

- Chair McCoubrey noted that the Police Advisory Board training was held on July 18th.
- Chair McCoubrey emphasized that all new members joining the Board are required to complete the training.

5. NEW BUSINESS

5.1. Senior Safety Program

- Chair McCoubrey attended the Police Advisory Board Meeting at the County, where Sharon Elliott presented on upcoming changes. Effective April 2025, Soldiers Memorial will reduce their funding for the Senior Safety Program, although the Annapolis West Health Foundation will continue to sponsor it. Chair McCoubrey remarked that the Senior Safety Chair performs significant work that alleviates responsibilities from policing services, ensures seniors receive proper care, and prevents the unnecessary use of police resources.

6. RCMP REPORTS

6.1 Quarterly Report: July 1 to September 30, 2024

The RCMP quarterly report for the period of July 1 to September 30, 2024, was circulated to all Board members.

Sgt Powers provided the Board and citizens with an overview of RCMP activities in the Town including:

- Road Safety and Impaired Driving
- Police Visibility and Community Engagement (including homelessness and domestic violence)
- Calls for Service
- Other things of note:
 - By the end of this week, all new Constable positions allotted for this year will be filed.
 - Positions for Annapolis members who have been identified for transfer out of the area already have incoming members assigned.
- Councillor Bartlett inquired about plans to enhance proactive policing in the town.

7. ANYTHING BY CITIZENS

- A citizen asked if someone would be available to cover the hour with the addition of the fourth person.
- Sgt. Powers replied that they don't have the resources to move to a 24-hour schedule, noting that the regular on-call hours are from 3pm to 8am
- Citizen Chris Bradley raised concerns about petty crime in the community, suggesting increased policing in Middleton during the evening, as that seems to be when vandalism occurs. He expressed frustration over receiving overly technical responses to simple questions about policing, questioning why resources aren't available at night.
- Sgt. Powers stated that just because no one is out during the evening, doesn't mean anyone isn't working over their scheduled hours.
- Citizen Octavia McLean mentioned that it's a partnership between the town and the police. She noted that there hasn't been a police presence at their neighborhood watch meetings, which occur on the last Tuesday of the month.

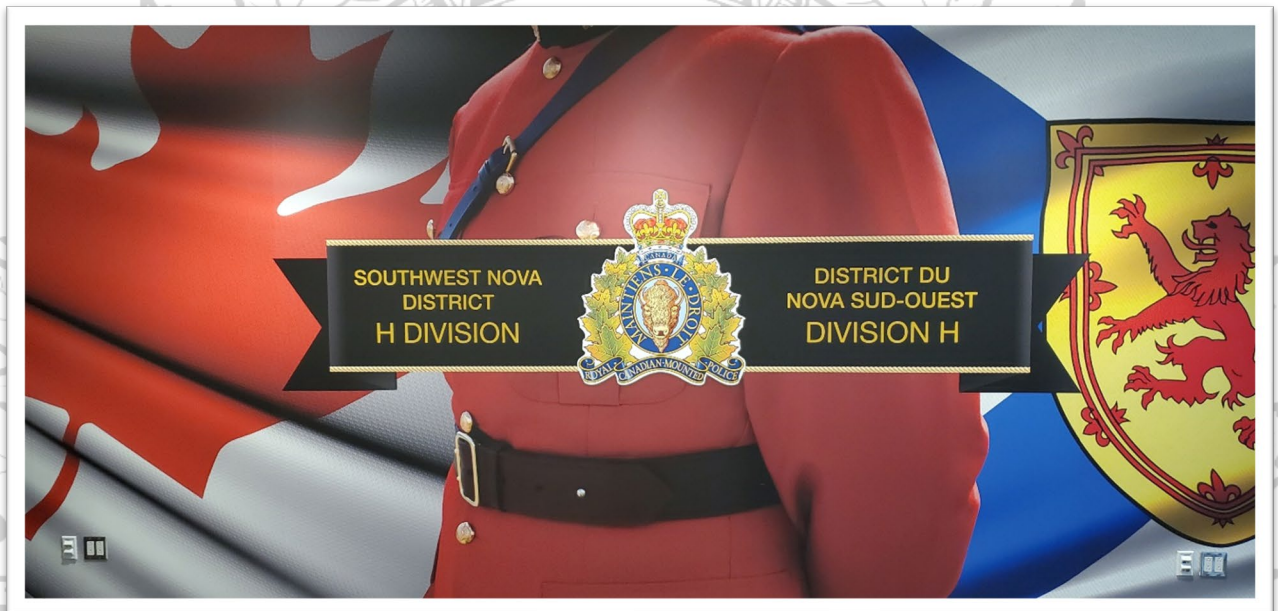

Middleton Policing Report October – December 2024

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Annapolis District Positions:

Staff Sergeant District Commander – Mike Maxwell

Sergeant Operations NCO – Lindsay Powers

Annapolis District is Policed by 18 General Duty Constable first responders.

Annapolis District Street Crime Unit is made up of two Constables. Soon to have a Corporal and two Constables.

Annapolis District Community Programs Officer is Adam Burns.

Annapolis District Senior Safety Co-ordinator is Sharon Elliott

Annapolis District Court Liaison Officer is Kim Muller.

Annapolis District has three Detachment Services Assistants who perform administrative functions between Bridgetown and Middleton Detachments.



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Quarterly Performance Updates:

The Annapolis District Unit Priorities run from April 1st until March 31st and are measured quarterly. This years objectives as identified through consultation with PAB's from the town of Middleton and the County are:

- Data Led Traffic Enforcement:
 - During this quarter the Middleton Detachment issued fifty tickets and eight warnings;
- Property Crime:
 - Of the 331 calls for service in the town of Middleton 1 Arson, 15 Break and Enters, 23 Mischiefs, 11 Theft Under \$5000 and 14 other theft type complaints;
- Comprehensive Education:
 - Senior Safety Coordinator Sharon Elliot has been meeting with seniors individually and as families to educate them on powers of attorney, wills, online safety and security and how to protect yourself from scams.
 - After the death of a local woman and three other intimate partner killings in the province, Sharon worked with partnering agencies to plan and deliver a safety and resource presentation for women. This was a partnership with Kings County Senior Safety, Chrysalis House, Victim Services, Middleton Collab Social Work and NS Mental Health
 - Community Programs Officer Adam Burns with the assistance of members of Annapolis District carried out four Cram the

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Cruiser events, a law presentation at the Middleton Regional High School, the Red Ribbon Launch (MADD), and a launch of the WITS and leads program.

- In addition, Adam and members participate at the Middleton Elementary Breakfast Program on Thursday Mornings; neighbourhood watch programs, Crime Stopper Meetings

Calls for Service

During this quarter, Annapolis District responded to 1408 service calls up from 1239 in the year previous. Of those 1408 calls for service 331 were in the town of Middleton.

Annapolis District RCMP seize firearms during search warrant execution

November 14, 2024
Meadowvale, Nova Scotia

News release

A search warrant execution led to the seizure of four firearms and other items from a residence in Meadowvale.

On November 7, officers from Annapolis District RCMP and Kings District RCMP executed a search warrant at a home and a garage in the 10000-block of Hwy. 201. Four people found at the property were arrested. Officers seized four firearms, including a semi-automatic rifle, as well as ammunition, gunpowder, and a conducted-energy weapon. None of the weapons were found to have been safely stored.

Darryl Dobie, 39, of Meadowvale, has been charged with nine offences, including four counts of Unauthorized Possession of a Firearm, Contravention of Storage Regulations, and Failure to

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Comply with Undertaking. He was held in custody and appeared at Digby Provincial Court on November 8. He was released by the court on conditions pending future court appearances.

Three other people were arrested at the time of the warrant execution. One woman will face a charge of failure to comply with undertaking. One man was arrested related to charges on a different investigation. Another person was released without charges.

This investigation was led by the Annapolis District Street Crime Enforcement Unit (SCEU) and the Valley Integrated Street Crime Enforcement Unit. The Valley Integrated SCEU is comprised of police officers from the Kings District RCMP and the Kentville Police Service.
